David Frum | KEYNOTE SPEAKER

A regular television commentator and a writer for Time magazine, CNN.com, The Week and the National Post, Frum served as a special assistant to President George W. Bush in 2001-2002 in a defining moment in American history. Frum is the author of six books, including two New York Times bestsellers: The Right Man: The Surprise Presidency of George W. Bush (2003), and co-author with Richard Perle of An End to Evil: How To Win the War on Terror (2004). In 1996, The Wall Street Journal acclaimed him as “one of the leading political commentators of his generation.” The Daily Telegraph’s 2007 and 2009 surveys named Frum as one of America’s 50 most influential conservatives. A graduate of Harvard Law School and lecturer at Yale, Frum also served as a senior foreign policy advisor to the Rudy Giuliani presidential campaign.

A British journalist, broadcaster, author and blogger, Phillips’ most recent book is The World Turned Upside Down: The Global Battle over God, Truth and Power, published in the US by Encounter in 2010. She is a contributor in the Wall Street Journal, the Australian, the UK Daily Mail, Standpoint magazine and a regular panellist on BBC Radio.
